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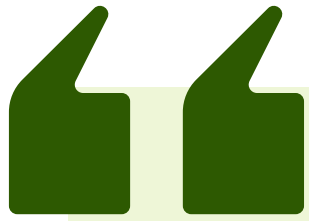

GATEWAYS TO FLOURISHING IN HARD TIMES (Part 1)

- BISHOP DAVID OYEDEPO



A Call for Spiritual Renewal Towards Flourishing in Hard Times

Nothing ever takes God by surprise. God knows the end from the beginning (Isaiah 46:10). He knows there will be hard times and has a rescue plan for His people. Our rescue begins with salvation but demands spiritual renewal for delivery (Psalm 11:3; Colossians 1:13; Hebrews 2:3). Behind the struggle of the redeemed is the lack of the fear of the Lord (Proverbs 13:15; Isaiah 3:10-11). Nothing flies in hard times like the fear of the Lord. Joseph flourished as a slave and prisoner because he feared God (Genesis 42:18). Daniel was indestructible because he walked in the fear of God (Daniel 1:8; Daniel 6:3-5). The fear of God gave him his place in destiny (Psalm 25:14; 1 Corinthians 3:11; 2 Timothy 2:19-21). Every great destiny in the Kingdom has its root in the fear of the Lord.

Revelation is inaccessible without the fear of the Lord (Psalm 25:14; Deuteronomy 29:29). God's covenants are revealed only to those who fear Him. It is time to renew our spiritual altar (1 Corinthians 2:14). God turned His back on Solomon His lover, so it is possible to lose the fear of God once you fall out of love with Him (Proverbs 1:23). The sure foundation of every great destiny in the Kingdom is a deliberate departure from whatever displeases God. No believer's life can be more fulfilling than his spiritual state (Romans 8:6). No one can sustain prosperity beyond his spirituality (3 John 1:2).

No one can command the supernatural beyond his level of spirituality (Acts 19:16; 2 Kings 4:31; Jeremiah 17:10). We must give appropriate attention to the foundation of our faith to give beauty to our destiny (Matthew 1:21; Psalm 37:18-19). Hypocrisy does not fly with God (Psalm 33:18-19; Exodus 10:22-23, 9:6). God's lovers are always exempted from evil. Our spiritual standing determines our standing in hard times (Genesis 12:3). The devil injects unrighteousness into the church to bring us outside of God's covering. When we lose our stand with God, we lose everything (Judges 16:20-21; 2 Timothy 2:21).

What is Spirituality?

- **A crave for godly living** - Exercising oneself unto godliness as a way of life (1 Timothy 4:7-8). A crave to please God at all cost (John 8:29; Hebrews 12:4; 1 John 3:7). What we read cannot change us, but only what we see in God's word (1 Kings 17:16).
- **A faith driven determination to live a holy life (1 Peter 1:15-16)** - It must be faith driven because we cannot make the determination by our strength or will (Philippians 3:13-14; John 1:17; 1 Corinthians 3:3). There is nowhere in the bible where sin is justified (1 John 3:8).

DAY 1

What is Spirituality? Cont.

- Delightful obedience to the commandment of scriptures (Psalm 112:1-3; 2 Corinthians 6:17-18) - There is a position to stand for God to be a Father to us and give us the needed covering (John 1:14, John 8:10-11). Jesus never condoned sin, but condemned it (Matthew 7:23; 1 Thessalonians 2:10; Romans 6:1; 1 Corinthians 9:27). Whatever truth God shows us from His word will show in our life because it changes us (Acts 24:16; 2 Corinthians 1:12). We need the testimony of our conscience and there is no way we cannot be proud and not know (2 Corinthians 4:1-2). Faith loses its potency where good conscience is lacking (1 Timothy 1:19, 3:9). Pure conscience faith is the faith that works.



Transformation begins with renewal of the mind (Romans 12:2). We need spiritual repositioning to possess our possession (Obadiah 1:17; Acts 20:32). Our inheritance demands sanctification for delivery. Sin is not a friend but an enemy. It always has a bitter end (Isaiah 25:6-8). It is not enough to be born again, we must endeavour to stay alive in Christ by staying off everything that kills and destroys (Revelation 3:11; 1 Timothy 5:6). Sin may be pleasurable, but it kills and destroys. Light is the only way out in these days of gross darkness (Isaiah 60:1-3). The enemy will try all possible efforts to block our access to light (2 Corinthians 7:1). It is time to start feeding from the word of God (Matthew 4:4; Ecclesiastes 9:7).

I have come to redeem my vow to the God of Bishop Oyedepo and to the God of Shiloh, who terminated 10 years of barrenness in my marriage. In 2016, I was appointed as the Secretary General of the ECOWAS Insurance Broker Scheme. My predecessor served two terms, which is 8 years. I prayed that I would do more than 8 years and even before the end of the 8 years, which is next year in 2024, my contract has been extended to an additional term beginning from January 2025. My family waited 13 years for these miracles of God. In all that time, nothing deterred my husband and I from serving God in our various capacities. I attended Shiloh's Mothers and Fathers of Nations classes from 2010 to 2020. In 2021, I believed God had heard my prayers. In March 2022, our father Bishop David Oyedepo admonished us to remain steadfast in our stewardship to God and told us to go and carry our Isaac. Then in August 2022, in the week of Spiritual Emphasis my word came. The Bishop began the week by saying he was going to show us a picture of redemption, divine health from the word of God. He gave an analogy of one being in the supermarket of sickness and disease and Jesus' blood was the price paid for our total health. Hard times have already commenced, and no one can pray against this because it is prophetic. We cannot pray against prophecy, but we can take a position as it applies to the fulfilment of the prophecy in our lives. In Isaiah 60:2, there is a clear demarcation between darkness and glory. Darkness is on one side and glory on another side. The scripture is telling us we should not worry about the darkness but expect glory when we see darkness.

Addiction to serving God is our security. The harder it is the more committed we should be (Malachi 3:16-18; Malachi 4:1-2). We become God's property and responsibility when we serve Him. Serving God is Key to our exemption. When we become children of God, we become entitled to inheritance but when we serve God we become entitled to rewards. Inheritances are promises but rewards are covenant. Promises may change but covenants cannot change. God answers promises to an extent, but He is committed to covenants. 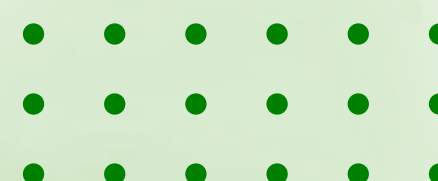
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No one can escape hard times (Malachi 4:1). However, there is good news for His sons. We will be going up and those who do not serve God will be going down (Malachi 4:1-2). We learn our way out of hard times and there will always be a way out (1 Corinthians 10:13). From scriptures it is discovered that all known servants of God enjoyed exemption in hard times. Shiloh is a learning centre and not a magical centre (Matthew 11:29).

Examples from the Scriptures of Servants of God who Enjoyed Exemption in Hard Times

- Daniel was exempted from destruction because of his commitment to service to God (Daniel 6:20-22). We cannot change God's ability, but we can activate God's ability. As we render our services to God, we are activating God's ability to work in our favour.
- Shadrack and Abednego were not consumed by fire (Daniel 3:28). Servants are always delivered because God needs their services (Daniel 3:17).
- Job was remembered for his services to God (Job 1:8-10).
- Hezekiah was exempted from untimely death because he was remembered for serving God (Isaiah 38:1-5).

When we serve God, He takes sickness away from us and we enjoy His covering on every side (Exodus 23:25-28).

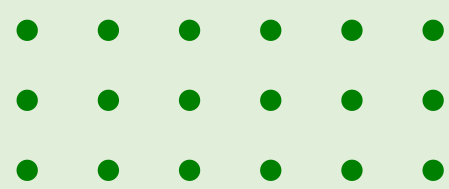


How to Serve God Acceptably?

- We must serve God lovingly (Deuteronomy 10:12; 1 Corinthians 11:13). Our relationship with God gives value to our walk with God (Isaiah 38:3; Romans 8:35; Songs of Solomon 8:6-7).
- **Serve God willingly** (Isaiah 1:19; 2 Corinthians 8:12).
- **Serve God dutifully and faithfully** (1 Corinthians 4:2; Matthew 24:45; Luke 19:13).
- **Serve cheerfully and delightfully.** Going about winning souls cheerfully. Our cheerfulness attracts God and helps us escape hard times (Malachi 3:14; Deuteronomy 28:46 -48).
- **Serve God continually** (Daniel 6:20-22; Galatians 6:9; Corinthians 15:58).
- **Serve God righteously** (Isaiah 52:11).

Platforms for Rendering Our Stewardship Before God

- The altar of prayer and fasting.
- Serving the Kingdom of God and its advancement.
- Praying for the salvation of souls and their establishment.
- Praying for the salvation of our neighbours.
- Praying for our pastors and ministers of the gospel (Colossians 4:12; Luke 2:37).
- Soul winning and their establishment (Matthew 28:18-20; Mark 16:16-20; Luke 14:21-23; John 4:35-36).



DAY 2

Confessing we cannot be poor is not enough to take us out of poverty. The worse form of deception is self-deception. We need to discover the secret of Kingdom wealth. We need an encounter of light to flourish in hard times. Hardship is a scriptural agenda that cannot be averted globally but can be avoided through covenant practice (Isaiah 60:2).

Hardship is a global problem, but it can be avoided if we practice what the bible says. Those who dismiss God's financial method will suffer financial crises. 'I don't have' is the mentality of a man who does not want to come out of hardship.



Factors that Secure Our Security in Hard Times

1. We must be conscious of our exemption status in Christ (2 Corinthians 8:9; Genesis 26:12; Galatians 4:28). No matter what is happening in the world, our case is different as children of God (Genesis 47:27). Our mentality defines our dignity, so we must see it, think it and believe to be able to enjoy exemption.

2. Embrace the love factor (Mark 12:30-31). Love is the foundation for all covenant practices and those who seek God do not sink (Matthew 6:33; 1 Corinthians 13:3). True love for God will make us place high value on God and His kingdom.

3. Understand the place of God's prophet in covenant harvest (2 Chronicles 20:20). A prophet plays a key role for prosperity in hard times (Hebrew 7:7). The voice we listen to is the voice that will benefit us. Our reaction to a man of God turns God's reaction to us (1 Kings 17:9; 1 Kings 17:13-14). Without a prophet we cannot make profit.

4. Obey the law of seed time and harvest (Genesis 8:22; Numbers 23:19). It is only those who plant their seed faithfully that will harvest bountifully. We can never come out of hard times except we are cheerful givers (Malachi 2:13; 2 Corinthians 9:7). We should put a smile on our face when giving offering because our seed is the voice that our financial future obeys. We can take a seed to meet any need. The exchange price of our future harvest is our present seed and every farmer gets a harvest depending on the seed sown. The best time to sow is during hard times (Genesis 26:12). Giving is the provider of the blessings (Malachi 3:10; Proverbs 10:22). Abraham had a blessing because he was a tither.

5. Live a life of patience. In the school of seed time and harvest, the day you plant is not the day you harvest. Patience is holding on to our desired harvest (Galatians 6:9). Patience is keeping a good attitude whilst waiting for the harvest. When our cloud is full it will empty itself.



UNVEILING THE MYSTERY OF SUPERNATURAL SUPPLIES

It is important to recognize that no one can operate in the supernatural with an illiterate mentality because as a man “thinketh in His heart so is he” (Proverbs 23:7). According to Scriptures the supernatural is expected to be the natural state of the redeemed (John 3:8). We are born to live supernatural lives, so it is expected to be the natural way of living and the natural lifestyle of every believer. Nobody can operate in that heritage without possessing a supernatural mentality.

The great challenge, therefore, is how we migrate from the supernatural realm? What makes it a challenge is that we are born through a natural process, we went through a natural upbringing, we went through a natural school system, we took natural professions or careers, we developed natural skills and talents, but we are ordained to live a supernatural life. That means that we have been so trained in the natural that we must be retrained for the supernatural. It takes a supernatural mindset to experience a supernatural lifestyle - this is a tasking migration and it is why we must position ourselves in a way that we transition our thinking from the natural to the supernatural.

The Importance of a Supernatural Mindset

God has packaged supernatural means to address the supplies of the supernatural. We’ve been told that as far as the prophetic calendar is concerned, the last days are ordained by God to be hard times for the world (Malachi 4:1). We are in the days where the shaking of the earth will affect every corner of it. There is no place to physically run to. We are coming to the days where the places that used to be called developed are entering very colossal struggles. These are the realities of the last days. The whole earth will burn like an oven. This is the prophetic calendar of God and it cannot be pushed aside by prayer. This means that in these last days, the world will be generally hard. However, for those who align themselves with God’s covenant, things will be personally sweet for them as this is God’s agenda for them. For it to be our personal experience, we require a supernatural mentality. We must recognize that the hardship is real, the hard times are here, but supernatural supplies are available.

Kingdom service is what provokes our access to supernatural supplies (Psalm 34:10). When serving God becomes our lifestyle, the supplies of heaven become our portion. We shall not lack any good thing. Serving God always procures His blessings.

Keys to Gaining Access to Supernatural Supplies

- Through the Covenant.
- Through obedience (John 2:5). Obedience is the trigger that provokes the release of heaven supplies. There is power in obedience.
- Through engagement on the harvest field.
- Through tithing.
- Through engaging with unconditional faith.

Staying in love with God makes a failure-proof believer because love never fails no matter the hardships in this earth.

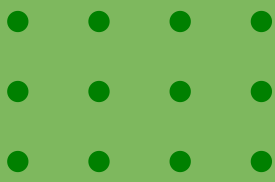
What is Love?

The bible is a prophetic bank and contains the surer word of Prophecy because it came out of the mouth of God (Isaiah 34:16). Those who have a prophetic perspective of the word don't have problems believing. God has an agenda as we see in the scriptures (Matthew 24:6-14). Prophetic words are not threats; they are the declarations of things that must be (Matthew 24:6-8; Luke 21:7-11). They are divine verdicts and pointers to prophetic events. They are not predictions, but God's agenda and no policy or circumstance can alter them.



Spiritual Challenges of the Hour

- Iniquity shall abound (Matthew 24:12). There will be new phases and models of sin. Sin will be redefined. We must wage war against iniquity so that it does not subdue us.
- The love of many shall wax cold (Matthew 24:12). We must keep our love on fire. We must not be discouraged because sinners are seemingly succeeding.
- The Faith of many shall fail (Luke 18:8, 22:31). Weak faith cannot stand the horrors of the hour, we must invest in building our faith. Our faith has unlimited capacity to grow.
- Many deceivers and false teachers will rise (Matthew 24:11; 2 Peter 2:1-3). We need to build ourselves so that the enemy does not take advantage of our ignorance (Titus 1:10; 1 Timothy 4:1-2).

Five Good News of the Hour

After spending six hours in the theatre, the surgery was stopped and I was told to return after six months so the procedure could be completed. This happened in October and I came to Shiloh in December and presented the case to God. I also attended the Healing and Deliverance class. When I returned home and went back to the hospital after six months, tests were done and I was told I would not need to undergo the surgery anymore. I am totally healed and I thanks to God.

I have come to appreciate God for terminating over 40 years of untimely death in my husband's family. Before now no male in my husband's family lived up to sixty years. I suffered multiple setbacks, and I threw myself into Kingdom advancement activities and put my marital issues on the back burner. Two statements by Bishop David Oyedepo kept me going. He said, "there is no star without a scar" and "the scar of every star is sacrifice". I prayed for other people to get married and last year God showed up. My introduction was done and this year I got gloriously married.

Hole in the Heart Healed - Comfort S.

The God of Shiloh destroyed the hole in my daughter's heart via the Shiloh mantle (prayer cloth). In 2018, my daughter was diagnosed of having a hole in her heart at five years old. Only the sanctified will be glorified (Romans 8:30; 1 Thessalonians 4:3-4). Sanctification is separation unto God for holiness, righteousness and uprightness. It is also a lifestyle of walking and living in the fear of God. It must be a feasible and tangible evidence. Sanctification will lead to promotion when we walk the path of the justified, just like Daniel and Joseph. Sanctification can also be defined as inner purity with outer reflection (Matthew 5:8). There is what to do to become sanctified (Hebrews 10:36; 1 Thessalonians 5:23). Prayer is not a substitute to the obedience of faith or scriptural instructions (Luke 6:46). We do not chat sanctification, we walk the path of sanctification. Only those who walk in the fear of God, thrive in hard times (Acts 20:32; 3 John 1:2). God will not give us more than what we can handle spiritually. Nothing terminates rising and falling like sanctification (Exodus 12:13). If the enemy cannot get us to sin, he cannot get us to fall. Sin is a bait of the devil to destroy the believer (Psalm 92:14).

What are the Demands of Sanctification?**Purify yourself**

Evidence of salvation is that you have left your sins behind. (1 John 3:3; 1 John 3:8).

Purge yourself of evil thoughts and imaginations

It is your responsibility. If you want to be sanctified, purge yourself (2 Timothy 2:19-21).

Flee youthful lusts

Avoid things you are craving after that are not of God (1 Corinthians 6:18).

Be committed to a lifestyle of watching and praying

so as not to fall into temptation (Matthew 26:21).

Put off the old man with his deed

Put off your old style of life (Colossians 3:9-10).

Put on the new man that is renewed

Put on a new lifestyle. There is no vacuum anywhere (2 Corinthians 5:17; John 10:10).

Give no place to the devil

Hold fast to your sanctification by giving no place to the devil (Ephesians 4:27; James 4:7).

Exercise yourself to godliness

Holiness is practical. We must always enquire what God will do in any situation before we take action (1 John 4:17; 1 Timothy 4:7-8).

Do not be unequally yoked with unbelievers

(2 Corinthians 6:14-18; 1 Corinthians 15:33).

Take regular showers in the Word of God

Feed your spirit by studying and meditating on the Word (Psalm 119:9-11).

Abstain from all appearance of evil.**Engage the Holy Spirit on the altar of prayer to mortify the deeds of the flesh**

Charge your spirit man by praying in the Holy Ghost consistently (1 Corinthians 14:4).

DAY 3

The Place of the Mind in Life's Battle

- The mind is important because it is the battlefield of the redeemed (2 Corinthians 10:3-5).
- Battle maybe fought with weapons, but they are won in the mind.
- Life is lived from inside out. You cannot win in the mind and lose in life.
- The state of the mind affects the state of life (Proverbs 4:23).
- The most critical target of any enemy confrontation is the mind.

Examples of People in the Bible that Lost Because of the Mind

- **The children of Israel** – They allowed Egypt to enter into them. The greatest challenge Moses had was not bringing them out of Egypt but purging Egypt out of them (Numbers 11:4-5; Numbers 14:26). After 430 years, the bondage transferred to their mind. And the older generation whose minds were not renewed perished in the desert.
- **Gideon** – The worst form of limitation is self-limitation (Judges 6:14-16).

Examples of People in the Bible that Won Because of the Mind

- **Joseph** – He prepared for the future he was seeing. He interpreted the dream to Pharaoh and also gave the solution to the dream. It takes your mind to enter your destiny (Genesis 41:14-38).
- **David** – He saw Goliath as an opportunity too big to miss (1 Samuel 17:46).



- **Isaac** - We must have a different mind to enjoy a different life (Genesis 26:1-3).

Impact of the Mind on Life

- The state of the mind defines the state of life. Mentality defines reality (Proverbs 23:7).
- The renewal of the mind equals the upgrade of life.
- A change of mind provokes a change of life season. Our season changes when our mind is upgraded (Luke 15:17-18).
- God hears and responds to thoughts like He hears and responds to prayers. Be careful, so that the thoughts God responds to are the right thoughts (Ephesians 3:20; Isaiah 65:24).
- The mind affects our access to God's voice. God needs the cooperation of our mind to do great things in our life (Philemon 1:14; Acts 10:19; Matthew 1:20; Job 23:13).

What to Do to Enhance Our Mind to Flourish in Hard Times?

- Avoid sin – Sin cuts short our glory.
- Avoid the wrong association and communication (Proverbs 13:20).
- Renew our mind continually with the Word because what we hear feeds our faith. What we hear determines what we fear (Deuteronomy 13:7; Romans 10:17).
- Think the Word, think productivity (Proverbs 21:5).
- Engage the power of the Spirit (2 Timothy 1:6-7).

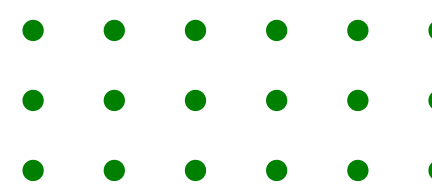

Thanklessness is one of the end-time plagues (2 Timothy 3:1-2). Thanklessness is a terrible risk. The mystery of thanksgiving is one of the mysteries of the Kingdom to overcome the problem of complaining. Thanksgiving is a choice not a gift. When you choose to be thankful, God will ensure you do not lack.

We must bless the Lord at all times because whatever we are going through, we are only going through, and we are not staying there (Psalm 34:1). Thanksgiving is the glue that attaches us to our blessings.



Why Must We Be Thankful?

- God deserves and demands our thanksgiving (Luke 17:17-18; Isaiah 51:11).
- Life is a gift not a right. Thanksgiving helps us to focus on God who is the giver.
- It preserves, multiplies and perfects God's blessings in our life (Malachi 2:2-3).

How Does Thanksgiving Enhance Our Flourishing in Hard Times?

- Thanksgiving provokes the continuous flow of fresh oil which empowers us to flourish in and out of season (Psalm 92:10-13).
- When we are genuinely thankful, it provokes divine intervention.
- Empowers us to live a supernaturally strengthened life (Nehemiah 8:10; Luke 10:21).
- When we are thankful, the prophetic Word is provoked for fulfilment (I Thessalonians 5:18).



THE SUPERNATURAL POWER OF FAITH (part 1)

What determines the destiny of the believer is faith (John 1:11-12; Matthew 9:29). Faith is the substance of Christianity. The Word will never become what it says without our faith. A believer has no identity without faith. The price Jesus paid will be wasted without our faith (Habakkuk 2:4; Galatians; 3:11; Hebrews 10:38; Romans 10:17). Without faith, we shut God out from performing. Faith is what determines the limit of our destiny. It is to everyone according to their faith. Faith demands all the attention we can give it. We cannot sink with faith. We only sink when our faith is not in place or not adequately built up to handle the storm. Faith comes as we keep hearing and understanding the Word of God (Romans 10:17; Proverbs 4:7). Faith has capacity to keep growing through spiritual understanding of the Word (Philippians 4:13). The greater our faith, the stronger our command of the affairs of life. We must build our faith to the point where anything God says is final. We must receive the grace to commit to whatever grows our faith.

What is Faith?

- Faith is obeying God to prove that we believe him; thereby committing Him to fulfilling His Word. Faith is not a belief system, it is a spiritual weapon.
- Faith is not waiting for God to work. Faith is putting God's Word to work so as to confirm His Word in our life. If we will not walk in the fear of God, we are likely to suffer hardship (Psalm 37:18-19).
- Faith is being fully persuaded of the truth, the prevailing circumstances notwithstanding until the truth triumphs. Truth will always triumph no matter the level of the enemy against it. When we get fully persuaded that this era of the church is our golden days, we will be at rest (Hebrews 10:35-36; 2 Corinthians 2:14).
- Faith is a spiritual force within us that determines the happenings of our life (Matthew 9:21-23).
- A display of confidence in God until what is desired becomes a reality (Hebrews 10:35-36).
- Faith is our access to a world of unlimited possibilities. It takes faith for God's people to subdue Kingdoms (Hebrews 11:33-34; Isaiah 53:1; Luke 1:45; Mark 9:23).





THE SUPERNATURAL POWER OF FAITH

(part 2)

Faith is the mystery behind the triumphs of the saints. This is the victory that overcomes the world even our faith (1 John 5:4). No child of God is permitted to live a defeated life. We have the heritage of triumphant living because of redemption. Faith makes us overcome the challenges of life.

What Makes Faith a Mystery?

- Faith is not a belief system. Bible faith is a spiritual weapon and listed among the whole armour of God (Ephesians 6:16). It has the capacity to handle attacks from anywhere with landslide victory, “unchequered triumph”. It is a dreaded weapon in the world of the spirit. Faith is able to disarm the enemy as if they never existed.
- Faith draws on the power of God to accomplish the impossible (Luke 8:46-47). Faith is the only way to tap into the virtue that heals and sets free. In addition, God delivered Daniel from the lion’s den because he believed in God (Daniel 6:23).
- Faith strengthens the believer to command the unimaginable and receive exploits that are yet to be seen (Hebrews 11:11-33; Daniel 11:32-33).

When faith is at work, our spiritual strength is in place to dare the unimaginable and forcefully deliver our desires. Faith is a mystery; it is not a principle nor an ideology (1 Timothy 1:19; Proverbs 24:10).

- Faith provokes the healing power of God to make us whole. When faith comes alive, sickness and disease take off (Luke 8:46-48). Faith has the capacity to heal all manner of sickness and disease.

What is Unique About Bible Faith?

- Bible faith is of the heart and not of the head (Romans 10:10. Mark 11:23). It is domiciled in the heart and not the head.
- Bible faith establishes our partnership with the invisible God, thereby empowering us to command the impossible. Faith makes God real to the believer (Hebrews 11:24-27)
- Faith thrives on what the eyes cannot see (1 Corinthians 14:17-18). Faith at work is God speaking to us from His Word. Rhema faith is the base of all raw faith (1 Samuel 3:2; Matthew 8:17).
- Every day is God’s day, the day we choose to believe is our day (2 Corinthians 6:2). There is no irreversible case with bible-based faith. Bible faith is never late for its delivery. Every time faith comes alive, God steps in to deliver. There is no closed case with faith.
- Bible faith unleashes its power through the tongue, whilst its base is in the heart. Bible faith would only engage through our tongue, as there is power in our tongue (Proverbs 18:21). Faith can only deliver through the declaration of our mouth (Mark 11:23).
- Faith is a mystery that puts believers on top in all situations of life. There are no private revelations in the Kingdom. Every truth of scripture applies and is accessible to whosoever believes it (Matthew 16:27; Mark 13:3; Ephesians 2:6). Every testimony is a pointer to whosoever believes it and is interested in receiving (Psalm 119:111).

If our strength fails on the day of battle, then our faith was too small to begin with. Faith never grows on assumptions but it grows on cultivation. We must build our faith before the storm arrives; otherwise, we begin to cower when we try to build it during the storm (2 Thessalonians 1:3). We must grow faith and not wish it. Prayer cannot deliver unless the faith of the believer is on the line (Matthew 9:28-29).

Every miracle must answer the faith question before delivery (Matthew 10:41). We cannot access what a prophet carries without believing in the prophet. Every good thing is our entitlement and heritage in Christ; however, we must tap into it through bible believing faith (Matthew 7:11).

SHILOH 2023 Testimonies

10 Years Delay in Conception Destroyed - Mr and Mrs Favour U.

At Shiloh 2021, we gave our December salary and connected it to our marital breakthrough. Last year April we were gloriously married. Shortly after our wedding, I was diagnosed with UTI, ovarian cyst and multiple fibroids. The fibroids were occupying 95% of the uterus. Regardless of wherever we are now, there is a new level waiting for us. God wants every area of our lives to be a source of reference to others. We are yet to operate in exploits if our results are not catching men’s attention. God’s end-time church is a church of giants, so we cannot end-up as dwarfs (Micah 4:1-2).

However, a principal requirement for us to be listed in the end-time army is meekness (Matthew 5:5). Meek people are blessed people. Meekness means to be humble. The opposite of meekness is pride. Meekness is one of the fruits of the Spirit (Galatians 5:22-23). Every one of us need meekness for the fulfilment of our destiny. What is in Meekness that Engenders the Birth of Giants?

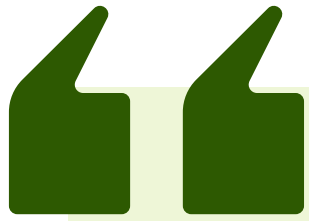
- **It enhances our access to more grace** (2 Corinthians 3:5-6). Grace is divine enablement. Anything great that happens in our lives is not due to our ability or capacity, but God working in us (James 4:6).
- **It enhances access to increasing revelation** (Psalm 25:9). Only the meek are teachable. The proud person “knows everything”. It is what God reveals to us that reveals us to our world. When we contact divine revelation, we keep going up in life.
- **It enhances a believer’s obedience.** Meek people respond swiftly to God’s instructions (Psalm 112:1-3). A meek person does not question nor analyse God’s instructions, they simply obey.
- **It makes great** (Numbers 12:3; Exodus 11:3). Every meek person ends up great in life.
- **It enhances access to divine guidance.** This helps believers to ride triumphantly in life. When God leads us, He leads us to a place of exploits. His leading may not be conventional, but it will lead to a place of surplus (Isaiah 48:21). When God is leading, there is no stagnation.

Examples of Meekness–Made Giants

- **Abraham** (Genesis 13:15). Abraham, in meekness avoided conflict and allowed Lot to choose where he wanted to settle. He recognised it was not just about his right, rather, a right-standing with God. He still ended up delivering Lot’s soul. A meek man cannot be cheated nor disadvantaged. Due to a heart of meekness, God swore a blessing unto Abraham (Genesis 22:16-17). He sowed in meekness despite the famine, in obedience to God. Meekness always enhances swift obedience.
- **Joseph** (Genesis 41:16-17). When God approves of us through our meekness, our greatness shows. God will always prove us before He approves us.
- **Gideon** (Judges 6:12-13). God is not looking for the strong, but the faithful.
- **Paul** (1 Corinthians 15:9-10). No one can ever outgrow knowledge and the only way to know more is to remain meek (Ecclesiastes 4:13).



DAY 4



PROPHETIC WARNING TO THE ENDTIME CHURCH

– BISHOP DAVID ABIOYE



A warning is a friend and not an enemy. When we ignore warnings, we end up in danger. Warnings are for our salvation (Ezekiel 3:18). In these last days, sin and evil abound and the church is complacent. There are a lot of alternatives being introduced to the church. We must avoid replacing the Holy Ghost fire with fun and excitement. The church must wake up. The churches in the book of Revelation are an example of the end time church (Revelation 2:3). Christians need to maintain the faith and not draw back (Matthew 19:30).

Why the Prophet Warning?

- **To raise alarm on the risk of spiritual slumber** – We must stay awake to keep the enemy away (Joel 2:1; Romans 11:8; Matthew 13:24-25). Samson and Saul suffered the consequences of spiritual slumber (Judges 16:16-19; 1 Samuel 26:7-8). The enemy can only steal when believers are asleep (2 Samuel 11:1-2).
- **To awaken the church to vigilance** – We need to be sober and not get carried away by excitement (Ephesians 5:14; 2 Corinthians 2:11; 1 Peter 5:8; Amos 6:2; Hosea 7:8-10; Acts 5:13). Let us therefore take heed, so as not to fall (1 Corinthians 10:12).
- **To maintain the purity of our faith** – Our faith has no future without a good conscience (1 Timothy 1:19-20). A call to repentance keeps our faith alive as iniquity abounds (Matthew 24:12-13; 1 Timothy 4:1-2).

What is Repentance?

It is soberly expressing deep remorse when we fall into sin. David repented and was forgiven by God (Proverbs 28:13). We receive mercy when we confess and forsake our sin. Repentance is not a once and for all event, but a once and again practice (1 John 1:6-10; Isaiah 59:1-2; Matthew 6:12-13; Hebrews 4:15). The churches in scripture received a warning to repent.

- **The Ephesus church** – They were admonished for leaving their first love (Revelation 2:1-7; 1 John 3:18).
- **The Smyrna church** – They were admonished for being fearful (Revelation 2:8-10).
- **The Pergamos church** – They were admonished for their immorality (Revelation 2:12-17; Numbers 23:21).
- **The Laodicea church** - They were admonished for their lack of zeal (Revelation 3:19).
- **The Thyatira church** – They were admonished for their immorality and idolatry (Revelation 2:18-24).
- **The Sardis church** – They were admonished for their spiritual death (Revelation 3:1-6).
- **The Philadelphia church** – They were admonished for their weakness (Revelation 3:11).

When we do not repent God turns away (1 Kings 21:27-29; Psalm 51:11; 2 Samuel 22:13).



ENGAGING COVENANT CHANNELS OF BLESSINGS TO FLOURISH IN HARD TIMES

The blessings of God make rich and adds no sorrow (Proverbs 10:22). We can walk in the fullness God's blessings when we know how to access them.

What are the Channels of God's Blessings?

The channel of obedience

The principal channel of God's blessing is through obedience. Obedience brings us into blessing and preserves the flow of blessing. Abraham had a flourishing destiny because of his tireless and cheerful obedience to God. He had a testimony that he obeyed God and walked under sworn blessings from God (John 8:38; Genesis 22:16; Deuteronomy 28:1). We have to know and embrace obedience to experience God's blessings. For example, only the blood of Jesus can clear our conscience (Mark 7:21-23; Hebrews 9:14; Zechariah 9:9-12).

The channel of parental blessing

Parental blessing carries the seal of longevity (Exodus 20:12; Ephesians 6:1-3; Genesis 49:22-26; Proverbs 20:20).

Let us be mindful of the devices of the enemy so as not to disconnect us from God's blessing (2 Corinthians 2:11; 2 Timothy 3:1-2; Judges 18:7-10; Luke 12:18-19).

The channel of priestly blessing

Priestly blessing is vital to access God's blessings (Genesis 14:19; Numbers 6:22-27; Hebrews 7:7; Galatians 3:29) and maintain spiritual covering (1Kings 17:15; 2 Kings 4:1-7; Luke 4:25-27). The priestly blessing requires our faith and sustained connectivity (Matthew 10:41).

The channel of godliness

Righteousness imbues boldness and a turnaround (1 Timothy 4:7-8; Isaiah 32:15; Proverbs 28:1; Isaiah 51:1-3; 1 John 3:7). Righteousness enhances the quality of life (Romans 8:6).



DAY 4

We are in a day of great contrast. The following contrasts depict the times we are living in:

A day of gloom and glory (Joel 2:1-3). A day of gross darkness and great light (Isaiah 60:1-3; Matthew 4:16). A day of devastation and celebration (Malachi 4:1-2; Malachi 3:6).

A day of despair and exemption (Exodus 3:21-22; Genesis 47:15-27). We should choose which side we are on. God will not choose for us. Obedience will keep us on the side of blessings and disobedience on the other side (Deuteronomy 28:1-14; Deuteronomy 28:15-56). Let's wake up and make responsible choices to decide which side to be on because days of trouble and triumph are here. Only those who are on the Lord's side shall be spared from the horrors of the end time (Exodus 32:26).

A Shift in the Spirit (Deciding Which Side We Are On)

- There is a shift from the realm of seeking self to the realm of seeking God first (Matthew 6:33; James 4:1-3). Until self is dethroned the future is not secure.
- There is a shift from the realm of faith to the realm of obedience of faith. Any faith void of obedience is fake.
- A shift from the realm of confession of faith to the realm of profession of faith (Hebrews 10:23).
- A shift from the realm of receiving to the realm of giving and receiving (Philippians 4:15-19). Our giving is not a donation. It is a covenant walk.
- A shift from the realm of seeking for help from God to seeking after God (Psalm 34:10).
- A shift from the realm of knowledge to applied knowledge.

Every testimony is a product of applied insight. We are created to carry signs (John 3:8). Every child of God is ordained a walking miracle (Isaiah 8:18). We are redeemed as signs and wonders to our world (John 2:5-11). Testimonies don't happen by chance. Applied insight is what triggers testimonies and supernatural manifestations (Philippians 2:12-13). It's time to take responsibility. When we commit ourselves to what He says, God is committed to perform His word. Every outbreak of light is a release of treasure (Deuteronomy 8:18). 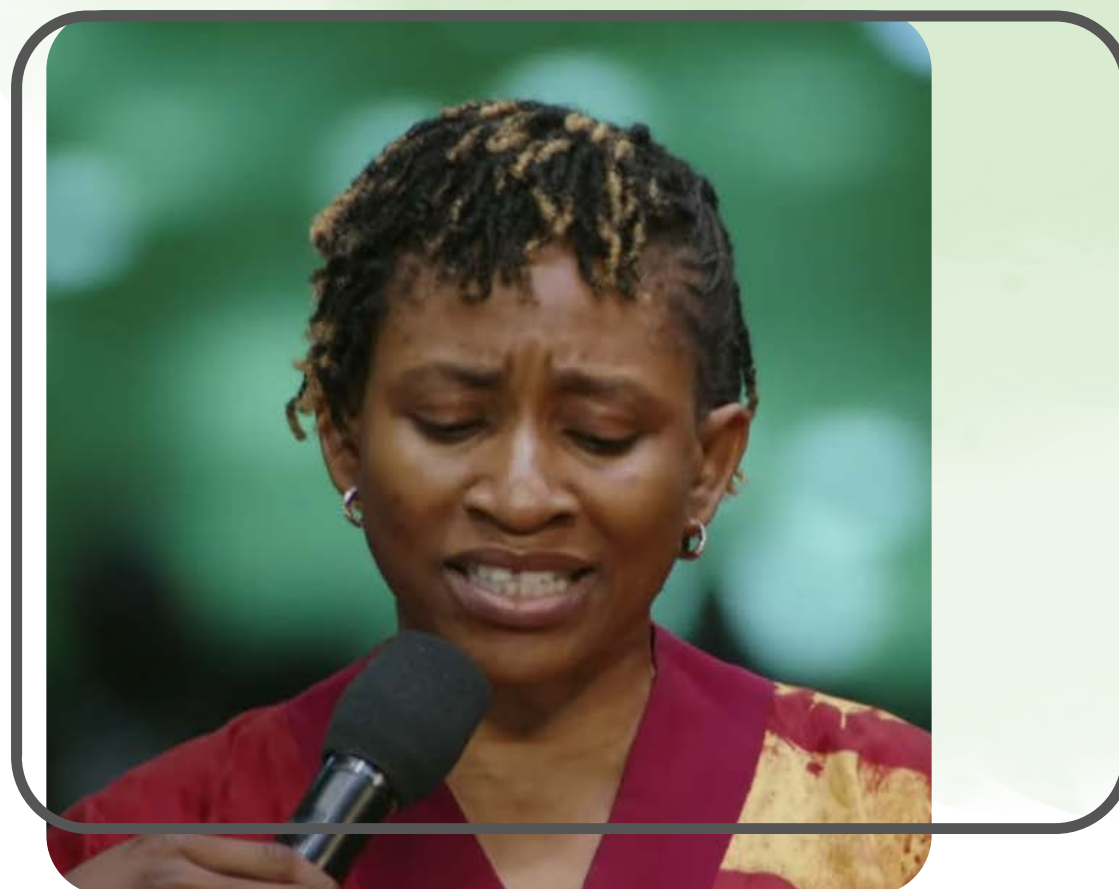

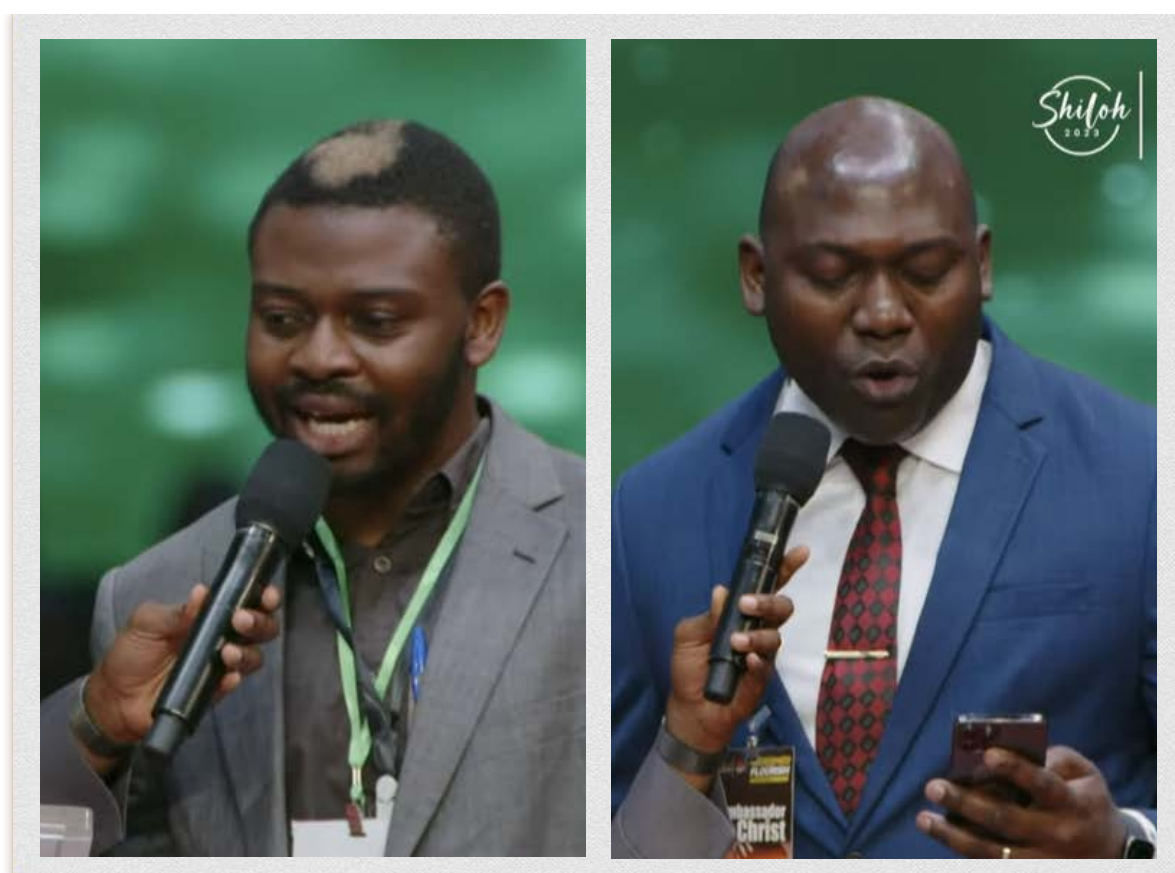


Multi-dimensional Breakthrough via Shiloh Encounter – Adeyemi A.

PATHWAYS TO ACCESSING IMPARTATION OF THE SPIRIT OF FAITH

Fear is a spirit of the devil and of darkness and faith is the spirit of God and light. Where the spirit of faith is the spirit of fear cannot dwell.

There is no force from earth that can dominate faith because faith has the capacity to quench all the fiery darts of the devil. At Shiloh one of the main captions is to dominate the land, that is what is done at Shiloh.

Dominion is only possible with the spirit of faith at work. Everything that God does comes through the channel of Faith. We are saved by grace through our faith; we are delivered by grace through that same faith.

It is through faith that Israel subdued kingdoms. It was through faith that situations and circumstances were subdued. Daniel and the three Hebrew boys subdued the enemy through their faith. The mountain moving faith put the enemy and all his cohorts to shame and that is the same faith that all believers need to exhibit to prevail.

What is Thanksgiving?

Thanksgiving is the will of God that makes Him fulfil His Word. After we have given thanks, which is the will of God, we can be confident that He hears us and we have the answers to our petitions.

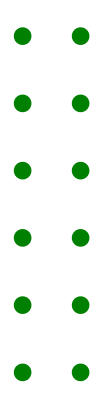
The Wonders of Thanksgiving

• **Answer to prayers** - If thanksgiving is the will of God in all situations, we need to know that God hears our thanksgiving the same way He hears our prayers. Thanksgiving brings speedy answers to a believer’s prayer. We have been told that it is possible to pray amiss (James 4:3). It is also possible to not pray as we ought to pray (Romans 8:26). Prayer can be limited, but thanksgiving cannot. We cannot thank God amiss. Those who thank God more see answers to prayer more.

• **Thanksgiving gives us access to an audience with God** – When we pray, angels are sent to attend to us (Daniel 10:1-14). The story of Daniel tells us that prayer can be delayed, but thanksgiving cannot be delayed. Why is this so? It is so because when we pray angels are sent to us, but when we give thanks, God Himself comes to us. Angels can be stopped, but God cannot be stopped. (Psalm 24:7-10). When you are a thanksgiver your prayer requests become less because you need less prayer when in thanksgiving. Everywhere in the Bible where Jesus gave thanks, He prayed less as in the story of Lazarus (John 11:40-41). In the words of Bishop David Abioye, ‘thanksgiving is the appreciation of God in anticipation of what He will do.’

• **Supernatural multiplication** – Jesus gave thanks for the five loaves and two fish and they multiplied (John 6:6-13). It is the appreciation of God that leads to the appreciation of men. In other words, nothing diminishes in the hands of a thanksgiver. Thanksgiving is a covenant multiplier in the Kingdom of God. When we pray God can add, but when we give thanks, multiplication happens (Jeremiah 30:19). When we understand this it will boost our performance and when understanding is buoyant, performance is seamless.

• **Supernatural victories** – Life is a battle and everyone is fighting one. Life is not a funfair but a battlefield. To keep enjoying supernatural victory, thanksgiving is non-negotiable. We see this in the life of Judah (2 Chronicles 20:1-3). God is the master strategist. When we pray, we are the ones fighting the battle, but when we give thanks, God takes over the battle. This is why it is called supernatural victory because we do not need to fight (2 Chronicles 20:22-24; Colossians 4:2). Until victory is sure, we cannot possess our possession. In every man’s promised land there are giants to stop you from accessing your possessions and this is why we need God by engaging in thanksgiving.



The Wonders of Thanksgiving Cont.

- **Supernatural turnaround** – Jesus gave thanks and Lazarus came forth from the grave. God turned around what looked like a dead or closed case. As we engage thanksgiving, everything that has been proclaimed upon our lives at Shiloh will become a reality.
- **Supernatural preservation** – God will preserve every blessing that has been delivered to us at Shiloh 2023 (Malachi 2:1-2). When you are not in thanksgiving, you lose your blessing. God has already spoken His Word and your blessing is sure because His Word has gone ahead of you (Psalm 56:4). God's Word is enough and He does not lie (Numbers 23:19).
